

*** PLAY BRIDGE COVID SAFE ***

We have tried our best to provide you a CovidSafe environment to play bridge, however we will also need your cooperation to achieve this.

- Please follow the government instruction for immediate isolation or monitor symptoms by checking the latest list of hotspots before you come in. The list is also displayed at the club entrance.
- Temperature check upon entry. We will turn you away if you have a temperature higher than 37.5C.
- Face masks are recommended, but they are not mandatory. Masks are available for you to buy if you forget your mask or want to use one.
- Our maximum capacity is 112 people.
- Please sanitise your hands before taking the cards out for the next round. Hygiene products e.g. hand sanitisers and alcohol wipes are provided at each table.
- Each player will have his own bidding box for the session. Used bidding boxes will be quarantined for at least 72 hours before reuse.
- Bridgemate are sealed in zip lock bags. Please nominate only 1 person at each , please view and accept results verbally. Please clean the zip lock bags of the bridgemate after each round if the session is run on a Howell movement.
- Be seated at your table and only move when the director calls for moving.
- Please bring your own pen if you would like to write on your personal score sheet.
- Individual packed tea bags and coffee sachets are provided. Fresh milk will be supplied in thermo jugs. Biscuits will temporarily not be supplied. Please bring your own snack. Please do not eat at the bridge table in regular sessions.
- Hot water is available in the club. The \$2 coffee vending machine is also available for freshly ground coffee. Mugs and glasses are available, the used ones will be cleaned in dishwasher after session.
- For catered events, please be seated at your table, the main meal will be packed in individual portion and be served to your table.
- Contactless payments are encouraged. You can use the button on the website to top up your PP account or to open a new account.
- Most important, please do <u>NOT</u> come if you are unwell or have any cold symptoms.

There will be some inconvenience under the Covid restrictions. We appreciate your understanding and we sincerely ask you to be kind and considerate to our staff, directors and the other players.
